Developing excellence in research and its management;


□Enhancing international cooperation between sending and hosting institutions;

To be considered eligible, candidates must:

- ✓ be a national of an EU member state or Japan /Korea
- ✓ Doctorates must have obtained a 2nd higher education degree from an EU or JP, KR Univ. within the Partnership in the academic year 2011/2012 OR be currently registered in a doctoral program in a Univ. within the Partnership
- ✓ Post-doctorates must have obtained their doctorate in the last 2 years AND must have the support of one of the EU, JP, or KR Univ. within the Partnership.








7- EM BEAM Scholarship awards – Phase I

-> 56 applicants seleted: 20 PhD/ 8 Post Doc/ 28 staff







8- EM BEAM - Phase II Call from July 1, 2011

EM-BEAM recruitment campaign:

- > 30 PhD -> 25 for 6 months + 5 for 12 months
- ➢ 6 Post doc → for 10 months

Deadline for applying: December 31, 2011 Start of your mobility: before June 30, 2012 Applications evaluated as received
