1- What is the EM-BEAM programme?

The EM-BEAM programme is a partnership of European, Japanese and Korean Universities. The project is financed by the European Commission and aimed at:

- ❑ Promoting the mobility of students, researchers, academic and administrative staff
- ❑ Developing excellence in research and its management;
- ❑ Enhancing international cooperation between sending and hosting institutions;
- ❑ Sharing of knowledge, know-how and good practices;
- ❑ Promoting transparency and recognition of studies and grades at international level.



2- Who can apply?

To be considered eligible, candidates must:

- ✓ be a national of an EU member state or Japan /Korea
- ✓ **Doctorates** must have obtained a 2nd higher education degree from an EU or JP, KR Univ. within the Partnership in the academic year 2011/2012 OR be currently registered in a doctoral program in a Univ. within the Partnership
- ✓ **Post-doctorates** must have obtained their doctorate in the last 2 years AND must have the support of one of the EU, JP, or KR Univ. within the Partnership.

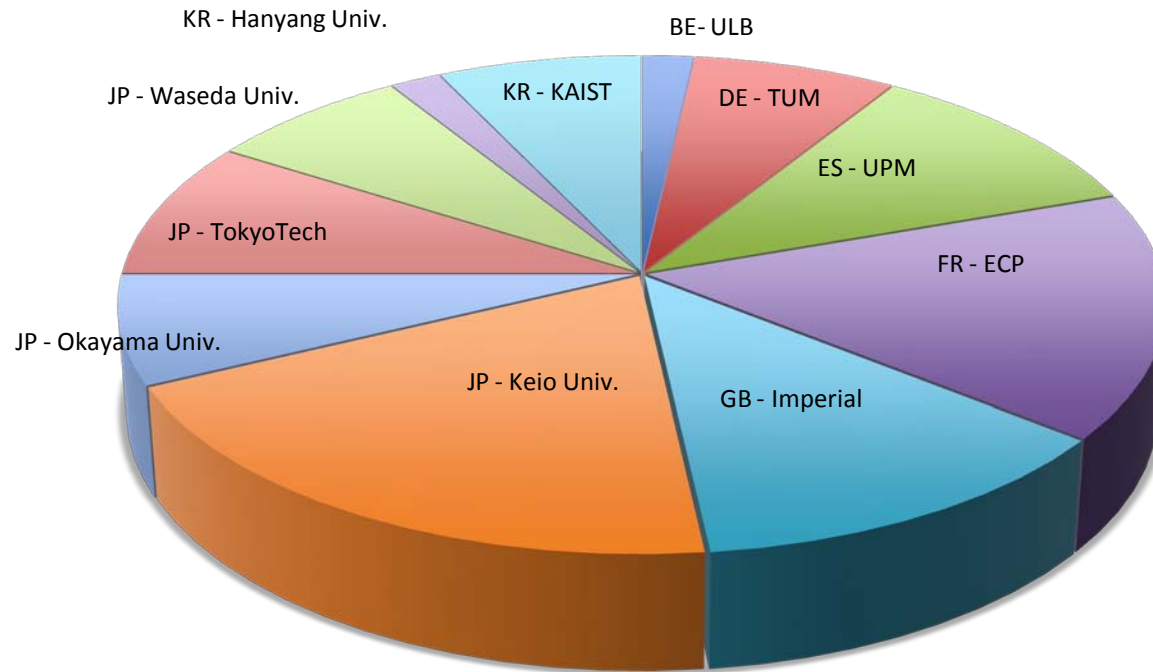

8- EM BEAM - Phase II Call from July 1, 2011

EM-BEAM recruitment campaign:

- 30 PhD -> 25 for 6 months + 5 for 12 months
- 6 Post doc -> for 10 months



Deadline for applying: **December 31, 2011**

Start of your mobility: **before June 30, 2012**
