

TSE Buddy System for Mutual Learning

- **By enrolling TSE Buddy System B4 students will get a chance to teach TSE students who have difficulties to complete retake courses with financial support via Zoom.**

- Buddy mentor : B4 TSE students including most recent early graduates
- Buddy mentee: B3 and B4 and above TSE students who have retake courses

- **Platform : By using slack students will find appropriate mentor/mentee by self-matching. TSE will start the project in Q2 FY2021**

- Feature1 : Buddy mentor will be paid for their TA role (personal teaching via ZOOM) hourly wage 1200 yen up to 2 hours once
- Feature2 : Buddy mentee will get learning support by mentor via ZOOM up to 8hours a month. If there are many applications, there are restrictions on participation.

• Procedures :

1. PIC will send a slack invitation mail to all B4 TSE students who do not have a retake course for registration as a mentor. After reading “ read me” and confirm and agree to operation rules, candidates will register as a mentor.
2. PIC may check mentor’s eligibility.
3. TSE students who have retake courses will register as a mentee by using the following form:

4. The mentor that meets the conditions attaches a reply at “ matching thread” in Slack and the matching is established.
5. Mentor will submit a monthly teaching report via Google spread sheet ; date, hour, teaching focus ,ZOOM URL, mentor’s comments, Mentee’s comments.
